At Marie Lecluyse Interior Architecture, all attention is given to environment, spaces and personality.

Starting from architectural plans or existing spaces, an overall vision is drawn out on plan. This is then followed up by a complete realization with a high degree of finishing and design in the finest details.

Renovation project "La Valeur Positive" is characterized by the use of natural stone. Here, too, interior designer Marie Lecluyse stays true to natural materials such as oak veneer, lime techniques and fabric. Marie's goal remains to combine these in a timeless way, but always incorporating that personal twist.

The home involves a remodel of a parents' home. In this, the task was to transform the house into a new home for a young family, without erasing the memories of the past. It was a must for the builder to give the wonging their own personality, thus making it feel like their own home and more responsive to their requirements. The organizational plan was designed differently in which views and walking directions were central. The choice and design of materials followed from the green environment in which the home is located.


At the center of the home is a massive block, the heart of the home. The center block is made up of several blocks of Picasso natural stone on top of each other, each alternating, thus giving 1 whole different functions.

For the master bathroom, a slightly less traditional natural stone was chosen, Traonyx. The natural stone forms the perfect synthesis of the colors inside the house. Making it absolutely not feel foreign in the home.

The natural stone was manufactured by PHD, Roeselare.






Fireplace socle in Pietra Calma, brushed and sandblasted. All natural stone works for this project have been realized by Philip Dumoulin.








Left page, above right and next double page: the kitchen island is clad with Picasso marble in a honed finish.
